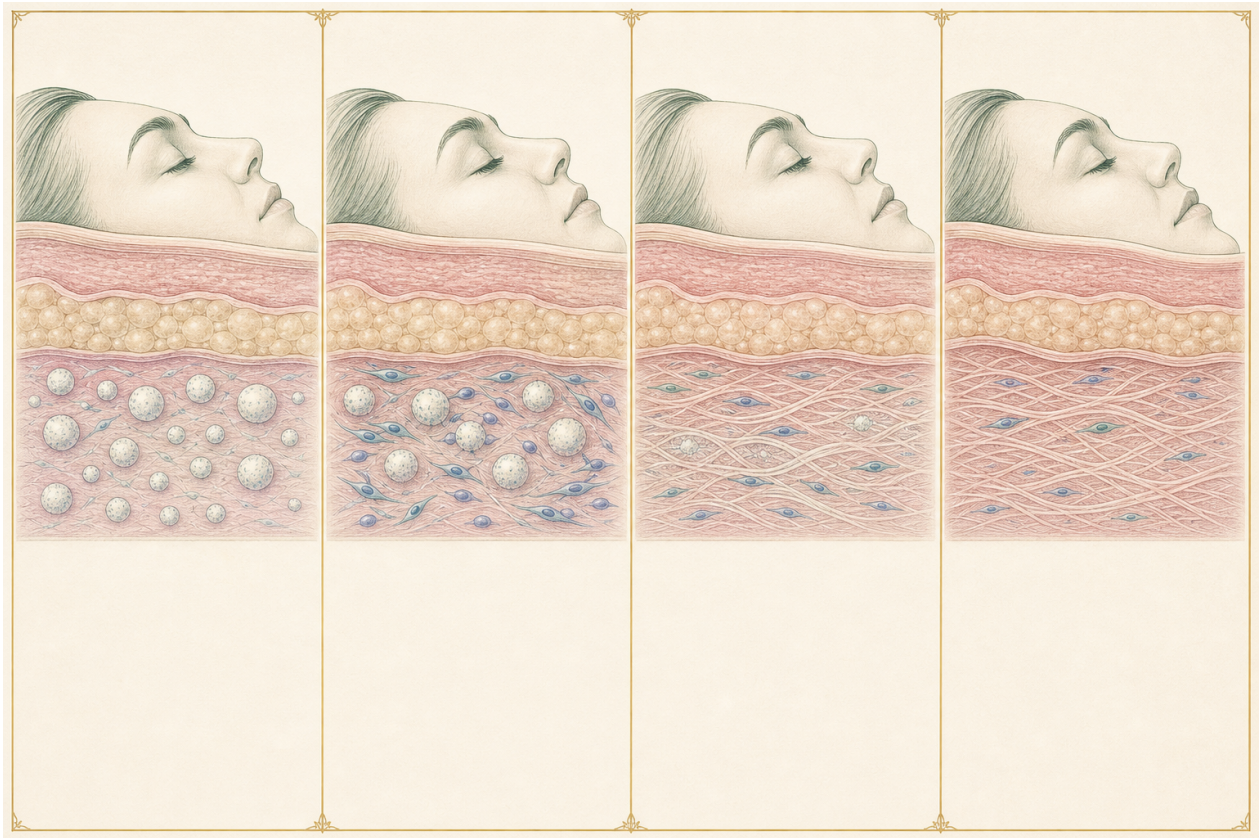


How PLLA collagen stimulation works

Understand why PLLA is gradual, how it differs from hyaluronic-acid filler and what happens as particles break down.



What it means

Poly-L-lactic acid is a biostimulatory injectable. Reconstituted particles are placed in selected tissue planes to create a gradual collagen response. Early fluid volume settles; the intended change develops over months and depends on vial count, placement and individual response.

Important limit

PLLA is not a same-day volumising gel and is not used interchangeably with HA filler. Nodules, swelling, bruising, infection and vascular complications require clear consent and management planning.

Route	Purpose	Starting point
Sculptra / PLLA	Authentic, traceable product with vial count agreed after consultation.	From GBP 399/vial
CaHA	A different injectable material for selected structural or biostimulatory goals.	From GBP 399
HA filler	A gel-based route when immediate support or shape is the priority.	From GBP 119/ml

A useful home-care foundation

- Use only sealed traceable product
- Follow massage instructions if prescribed
- Expect gradual change
- Attend planned reviews

Pause and seek appropriate review when

- Active infection
- Autoimmune or healing concern requiring review
- Immediate-result expectation
- Area or goal outside product instructions
